1 Overview

1.1 About Beliefnet

Beliefnet is a multi-faith website and e-community designed to help people meet their own religious and spiritual needs in an interesting, captivating and engaging way. The mobile Beliefnet application provides wireless access to resources such as daily newsletters, faith-based discussion groups, prayer circles, and inspirational images that can be downloaded to your handset as wallpapers/screensavers



1.2 Registration

In order to take advantage of all the features available in the Beliefnet application, registration is required. You can register on line at www.beliefnet.com. *Registration is required before you post to a discussion group or prayer circle.* When you register, you will setup a user name and password and will be introduced to Beliefnet's Rules of Conduct, which help ensure a safe and constructive community environment. Your username and password will be used during a one-time login process on your mobile phone before you post your first message.

1.3 Logging on to your Phone

Before you are able to post your first message to a discussion group or prayer circle, you will be required to logon to your phone. Enter the username and password (using the handset keypad) that you set up for yourself during registration at www.beliefnet.com (See 1.2 Registration) when prompted by the application on your phone. You will not be prompted to login until you try to post a message for the first time. After you logon the first time, your information is saved on the phone and you will not be asked to logon again from your phone.

1.4 Rules of Conduct


During the on-line registration process, you will be presented with the full text of the Beliefnet Rules of Conduct. Included here is a summary of those Rules.

If you post messages in Beliefnet discussions or prayer circles, you agree to observe the Beliefnet Rules of Conduct (ROC). Beliefnet will not censor you for beliefs or opinions, within the limits of the ROC, but will stop disruptive behavior. Community members should express opinions about a person's ideas, not their character. You agree not to: make negative remarks about members; engage in hate speech; advocate violence; try to convert another person's religious beliefs; disrupt conversations; post site complaints; advertise or solicit on behalf of commercial, religious, charitable or other causes. You agree to obey local guidelines. Consult Beliefnet website (www.beliefnet.com) for full Rules of Conduct.

2 Quick Start Guide

The mobile Beliefnet application provides wireless access to daily newsletters, discussion groups, prayer circles, and inspirational images that can be downloaded to your handset for use as wallpapers or screensavers.

To use the Beliefnet application:

- 2.1 Find the BREW™ applications folder on your BREW enabled phone.
- 2.2 Select the Beliefnet application icon and press OK/Select 
- 2.3 Use the top/bottom and left/right scroll keys to navigate through the main menu options. Use the OK/Select key to select highlighted menu items and bring up pop-up menus with available actions
- 2.4 Choose from six options available from the main menu:
 - 2.4.1 Daily Newsletters – View inspiration messages and words of wisdom from a variety of sources. Choose from seven different categories.
 - 2.4.2 My Newsletters – View saved newsletters and set delivery options to automatically receive a new newsletter every day.
 - 2.4.3 Images – Browse through a variety of inspirational and spiritual images. You can even download your favorite image for use as a wallpaper or screen saver.
 - 2.4.4 Discussion Groups – Come here to participate in discussion groups on a wide range of topics. Check out featured discussions or search for discussions on a topic of your choice. You can read through discussion posts and even post your own comments.
 - 2.4.5 Prayer Circles – Participate in a prayer circle by reading prayers posted by community member or even posting your own prayer to an existing prayer circle.
 - 2.4.6 Help – Get help straight from your handset. Instructions on how to navigate and use the application is always available.
- 2.5 Use the End key on your mobile phone to exit the application

3 Daily Newsletters

3.1 Select Daily Newsletters

Beliefnet provides access to a variety of newsletters reflecting different faiths. To access the menu of daily newsletters, select the 'Daily Newsletters' icon from the main menu



3.2 Select Newsletter to View

Use the up/down cursor keys to scroll through the various newsletter titles. Once you have selected a newsletter title, press the right arrow to select a particular date, using the up/down arrow keys to change the month, and the left/right keys to move to day and year entries. Once you have the newsletter title and date set, press the "OK/Select" key to view that newsletter.



3.3 Adding Newsletter to Favorites

After viewing a newsletter, you can save it to your favorites, in 'My Newsletters', by pressing "OK/Select" while viewing the newsletter, and selecting "Add to Favorites" from the pop-up menu. This newsletter will now be stored under the 'My Newsletters' main menu in the 'My Favorites' section.

To return to the main menu, select "Home" and press "OK/Select".



4 My Favorites

To view 'My Favorites', press "OK/Select" on the 'My Favorites' icon. 'My Favorites' is where newsletters are saved. You may save up to 20 newsletters.



4.1 My Favorites

4.1.1 Viewing Saved Newsletters

To view newsletters saved in 'My Favorites', press "OK/Select" on 'My Favorites' in the 'My Newsletters' menu. This will bring up a list of all newsletters that have been added to your favorites. To select a newsletter, press up/down until the desired newsletter is highlighted, then press "OK/Select". A menu will appear allowing you to "View" the newsletter or "Remove" it from your list of favorites. Select "View" and press "OK/Select" to view the Newsletter



4.1.2 Removing Saved Newsletters

To remove newsletters saved in 'My Favorites', from the main menu press "OK/Select" on 'My Favorites' in the 'My Newsletters' menu. This will bring up a list of all newsletters that have been added to your favorites. Press up/down until the desired newsletter is highlighted, then press "OK/Select". A menu will appear allowing you to "View" the newsletter or "Remove" it from your list of favorites. Select "Remove" and press "OK/Select" to remove the Newsletter from your list of favorites.

5 Images

5.1 Select Images from Main Menu

To view and download images from Beliefnet, press “OK/Select” on the ‘Images’ icon from the main menu. These images can be viewed on your phone and may also be downloaded to the phone for use as a screensaver or wallpaper. Refer to your phone’s user manual for instructions on setting up your phone’s wallpaper, screensaver, and picture viewer applications



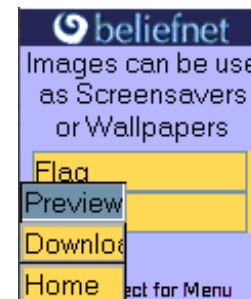
5.2 Select Image Category

Use the up/down arrow keys to scroll through the image categories. Press “OK/Select” on the desired category to bring up a list of available images.



5.3 View Image

Use the up/down arrow keys to scroll through the images. Press “OK/Select” on the desired image. A pop-up menu will appear. Select “Preview” to view the image on your phone. Select “Home” to return to the main menu.



5.4 Download Image

Use the up/down arrow keys to scroll through the list of images. Press “OK/Select” on the desired image. A pop-up menu will appear. Select “Download” to download the image to your phone. When downloading an image, a message will notify you of the successful download. You may also download the image while viewing the image. While the image is displayed, press “OK/Select” to bring up the pop-up menu and select “Download”.

6 Discussion Groups

Discussion Groups provide a place for Beliefnet members to discuss issues of faith, spirituality, and other topics of interest. Each discussion group is a thread or collection of community member posts regarding a specific topic. Members post their own thoughts and respond to those of other members participating in the group.

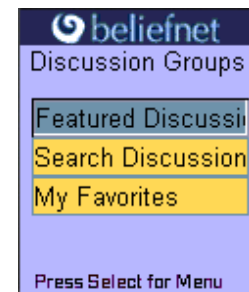
To participate in a discussion group, press “OK/Select” on the ‘Discussion Groups’ icon from the main menu.



6.1 Featured Discussions

6.1.1 Viewing featured discussion groups

Featured Discussions are specially selected topics tailored for the mobile user. To view a list of Featured Discussions, use the up/down arrow keys to scroll to the “Featured Discussions” menu item and press “OK/Select”.



6.1.2 Selecting a discussion group

After selecting “Featured Discussions”, you will see a list of the current featured discussion groups. You may then scroll up/down through the list of discussion groups until you highlight the group you want. Press “OK/Select” and select “View” to view the posts for the selected discussion group. Viewing the discussion will pull up the **first** post for this discussion group.

6.1.3 Viewing posts in a discussion group

Selecting a discussion group will display the **first** post in the discussion thread. To view additional posts in this discussion group, press “OK/Select” while viewing the post. A pop up menu will appear. Select:

- “Next” – to view the next post in the thread
- “Last” – to view the last post in the thread
- “First” – to return to the first post in the thread
- “Previous” – to view the previous post in the thread
- “Home” – to return to the main menu
- “Post” – to post a message to the group

6.1.4 Posting a message to a discussion group

While viewing posts to a discussion group, you may choose to contribute to the discussion by posting your own thoughts on the topic. To post a message to a discussion group:

- 6.1.4.1 Press “OK/Select” while viewing the post. A pop up menu will appear. Use the up/down and right/left arrows to highlight “Post” and press “OK/Select”.
- 6.1.4.2 If this is the first time you will post a message, you will be required to logon to your phone first (see 1.3 “Logging on to your Phone”).
- 6.1.4.3 A blank text box will appear. Use your handset keypad to type your message (see phone user manual for more information).
- 6.1.4.4 When you are finished with your message, press “OK/Select”, highlight “Post”, and press “OK/Select” again to post your message. *Once your message is posted, it cannot be deleted.* To abandon the message before posting, press “OK/Select”, highlight “Exit”, and press “OK/Select”.

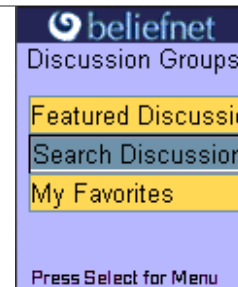
- 6.1.4.5 To view your post immediately after posting, press “OK/Select” while viewing the discussion and select “Last” from the pop-up menu. Your post will be displayed and will also be visible at www.beliefnet.com.

6.2 Search Discussions

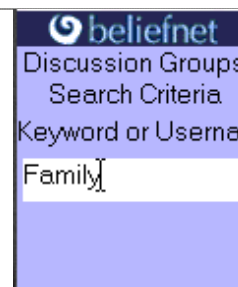
6.2.1 Searching for discussion groups

You can search through Beliefnet’s entire collection of discussion groups to find the topic you want to discuss. To search for a discussion, use the up/down arrow keys to scroll to the “Search Discussions” menu item and press “OK/Select”.



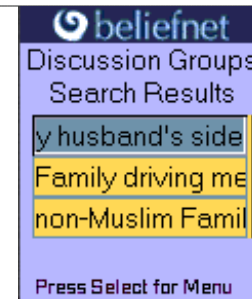
6.2.2 Entering search criteria

Type a keyword term in the text box, then press “OK/Select”. For instance, if you want to search for a discussion on family, type in the word “family” using your handset keypad and press “OK/Select”.



6.2.3 Viewing search results

The application will return all discussion groups with the characters 'family' in the title. Up to the first 20 search results for 'family' will be shown on the screen. To see the next 20 results (if available), use the up/down arrow keys until "Next" is highlighted, then press "OK/Select". Select "Previous" to go back to the prior list of 20 discussion groups. To view a discussion, highlight the group you want, press "OK/Select" and select "View".



For more information on viewing a discussion, reading through discussion posts, or posting a message to a discussion, please see 6.1 Featured Discussions.

6.3 My Favorites

You can save your favorite discussion groups to a folder called "My Favorites" for quick and easy access. You can save up to 20 discussion groups to My Favorites.

6.3.1 Adding Discussion Groups to My Favorites

To add a Discussion Group to My Favorites, highlight the discussion group title, press "OK/Select" and select "Add to Favorites" from the pop-up menu. This discussion group will now be saved in 'My Favorites' under 'Discussion Groups'

6.3.2 Accessing Discussion Groups in My Favorites

You can access 'My Favorites' from the 'Discussion Groups' main menu by using the up/down arrow keys until 'My Favorites' is highlighted, then press "OK/Select". This will bring up a list of all discussion groups that you have added to "My Favorites". To view a discussion, use the up/down arrow keys until the desired discussion is highlighted, press "OK/Select" and select "View".

6.3.3 Removing Discussion Groups from My Favorites

You can remove discussion groups from 'My Favorites'. From the 'Discussion Groups' main menu, use the up/down arrow keys until 'My Favorites' is highlighted, then press "OK/Select". This will bring up a list of all discussion groups that you have added to "My Favorites". To remove a discussion, use the up/down arrow keys until the desired discussion is highlighted, press "OK/Select" and select "Remove".

To return to the main menu, select "Home" and press "OK/Select".

7 Prayer Circles

Prayer Circles provide a place for Beliefnet members to ask for prayers for themselves or for loved ones. Each prayer circle is comprised of the original request for a prayer, including information about what is being prayed for, and the prayers of the community members on behalf of the prayer requestor.

To participate in a prayer circle, press “OK/Select” on the ‘Prayer Circle’ icon from the main menu.



7.1 Selecting a prayer circle

After selecting ‘Prayer Circle’, you will see a list of the current prayer circles. You may then scroll up/down through the list until you highlight the prayer circle you want. Press “OK/Select” and select “View” to view the posts for the selected prayer circle. Viewing the prayer will pull up the **prayer request** for the prayer circle.

7.2 Viewing posts in a prayer circle

Selecting a prayer circle will display the **prayer request** for the prayer circle. To view the prayers, press “OK/Select” while viewing the post. A popup menu will appear. Select:

- “Next” – to view the next post in the thread
- “Last” – to view the last post in the thread
- “First” – to return to the prayer request
- “Previous” – to view the previous post in the thread
- “Home” – to return to the main menu
- “Post” – to post a message to the group

7.3 Posting a message to a prayer circle

While viewing posts to a prayer circle, you may choose to contribute by posting your own prayer. To post a prayer to a prayer circle:

- 7.3.1 Press “OK/Select” while viewing the post. A pop up menu will appear. Use the up/down and right/left arrows to highlight “Post” and press “OK/Select”.
- 7.3.2 If this is the first time you will post a message, you will be required to logon to your phone first (see 1.3 “Logging on to your Phone”).

-
- 7.3.3 A blank text box will appear. Use your handset keypad to type your message (see phone user manual for more information).
 - 7.3.4 When you are finished with your message, press “OK/Select”, highlight “Post”, and press “OK/Select” again to post your message. *Once your message is posted, it cannot be deleted.* To abandon the message before posting, press “OK/Select”, highlight “Exit”, and press “OK/Select”.
 - 7.3.5 To view your post immediately after posting, press “OK/Select” while viewing the prayer and select “Last” from the pop-up menu. Your post will be displayed and will also be visible at www.beliefnet.com.
