

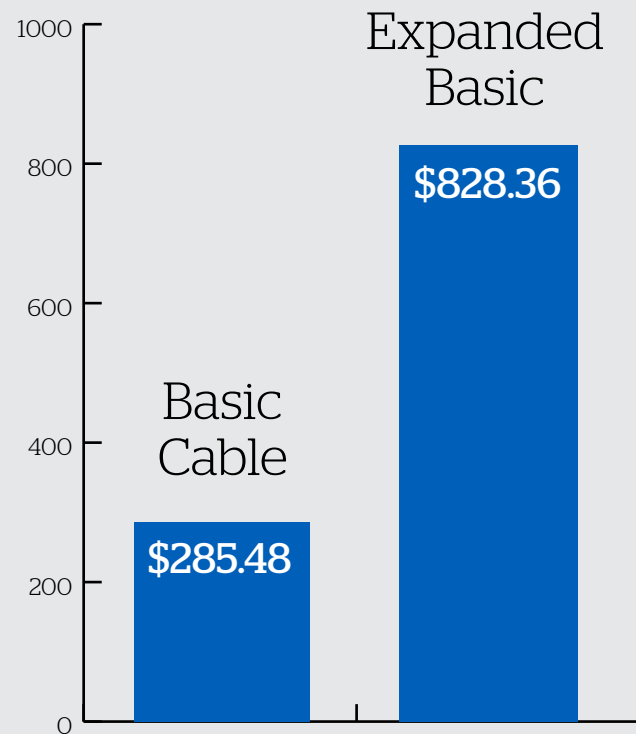

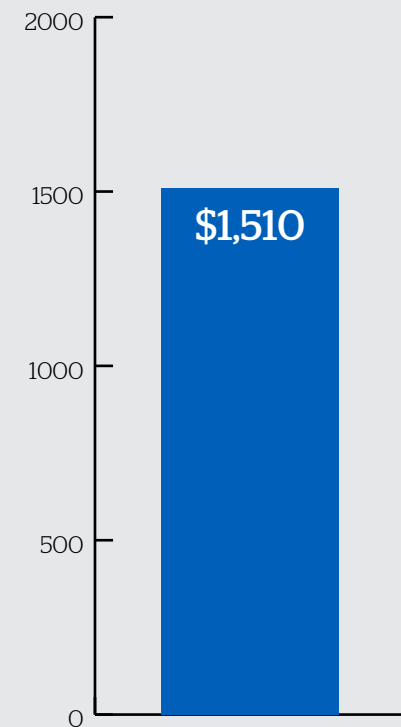
U.S. Cellular's high-speed network allows consumers to ditch the landline, cable, and internet provider, saving hundreds of dollars annually.

## Cable cost<sup>1</sup>



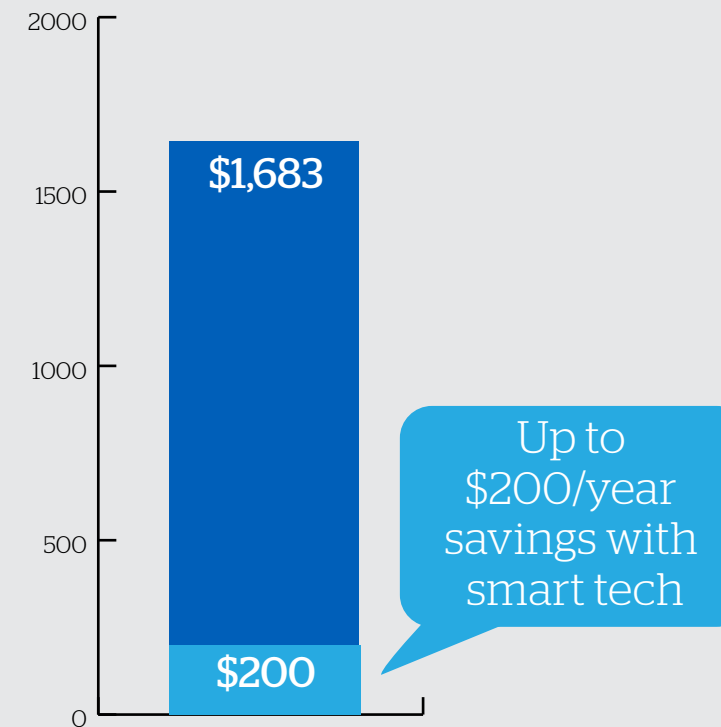

## Telephone Service cost<sup>2</sup>



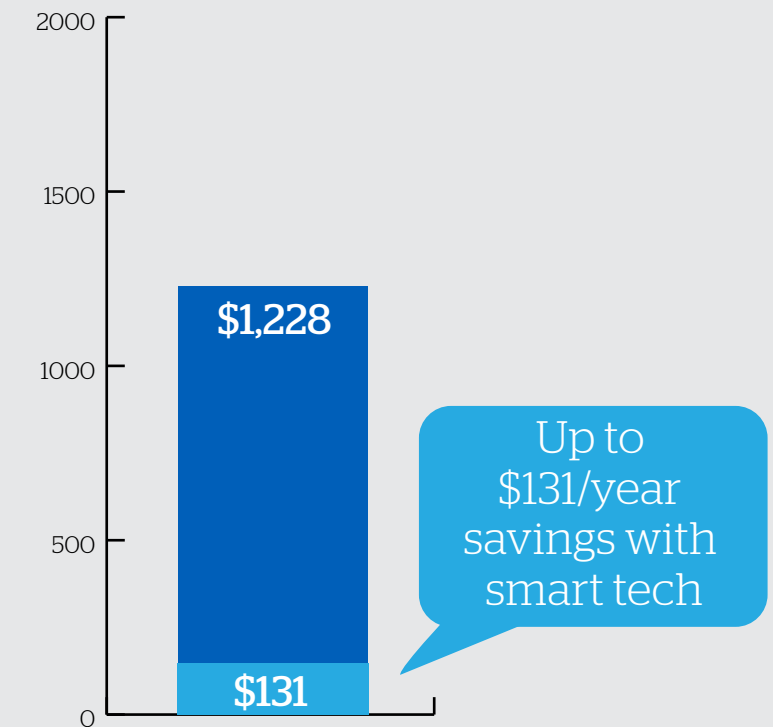
